



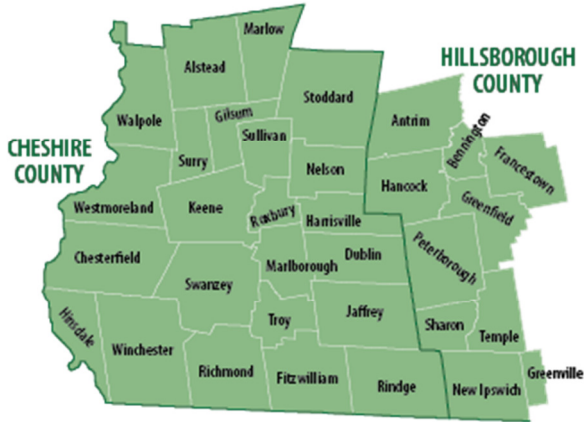

New Era Begins for CVTC



On July 1st, CVTC officially starts serving all 33 towns in the Monadnock region with our Volunteer Driver Program. Up until now, CVTC has served the 10 towns in Hillsborough County along with Rindge, Jaffrey and Dublin.

Riders in Cheshire County have started booking their July trips and beyond with CVTC. Yet, there is still much to do!

Re-building the Volunteer Driver base in Cheshire County (Keene and surrounding towns) is our immediate focus!

Currently, we have a 12 former Red Cross drivers signing up along with four new folks that responded to ads or the article posted in the Keene Sentinel. Ideally, we'd like to recruit

another 25 for 40+ active drivers in Cheshire County for a region-wide total of 100 Drivers.

Jack Calhoun, consultant for CVTC through a grant from the *Endowment for Health*, is working to build capacity in Cheshire County. He is meeting with churches and civic organizations suggesting they include Volunteer Driving as part of their Outreach Program as the need is so great. Jack will be working through July.



CVTC will share the road with HCS's Friendly Bus and City Express serving the residents of Keene, and the Disabled American Veteran Transportation program providing trips to VA Hospitals and Clinics. We look forward to working more closely with both organizations to provide a robust community transportation program.

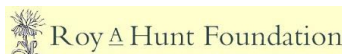

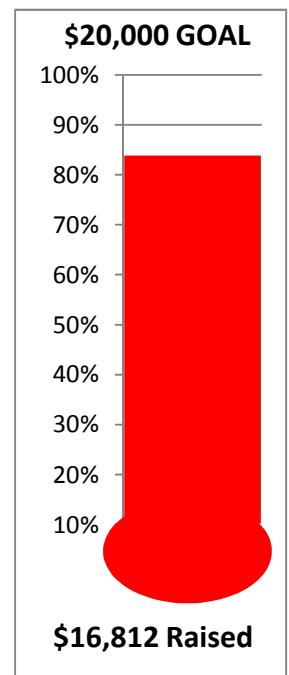

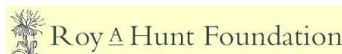
