Volunteer Driver Program

CVTC's Volunteer Drivers provide "no fee" transportation for people who do not have access to transportation because of age, ability, economic situation or other limiting circumstances. Trip purposes include non-emergency medical and social service appointments, as well as trips to the grocery store, the pharmacy, and post office.

Drivers select rides based on their availability. We give the rider 48 hours' notice if the ride is not selected.

Taking care of yourself can't be on top of the list if your day-to-day responsibilities and needs aren't being met. That's where CVTC comes in. By providing transportation services, we can help meet basic life needs, making it easier and less stressful for you to focus on your health.

In 2020, 71 Volunteer Drivers served 234 riders from 34 towns in the Monadnock Region (see map of towns). The drivers logged in 69,918 miles and donated 3,474 hours of their time.

Our Riders report that since getting rides through CVTC, they:

- ▶ feel less of a burden on family and friends
- ▶ are able to remain independent
- ▶ do not hesitate in making necessary medical or social service appointments
- ▶ eat healthier meals
- ▶ are satisfied with CVTC's services


Become a Volunteer Driver

CVTC gives hope with every mile you drive.

We enroll Volunteer Drivers to get people where they need to go. If you have some time now and then to give someone a ride, we'd enjoy hearing from you.

When you become a CVTC Volunteer Driver:

- ▶ Select the trips that match your availability
- ▶ You use your own vehicle
- ▶ Must carry a minimum of \$100,000/\$300,000 liability on car insurance
- ▶ Once vetted, we provide an orientation and training on TripList, our online trip management system
- ▶ If you don't use a computer, our staff will help you select trips and complete monthly mileage logs
- ▶ See details of the trip you selected on TripList, including helpful information about each rider (uses a cane or walker, etc.)
- ▶ Choose to receive monthly mileage reimbursement at \$0.56 per mile (provided by federal funds)
- ▶ Receive daily email reminders about open trips
